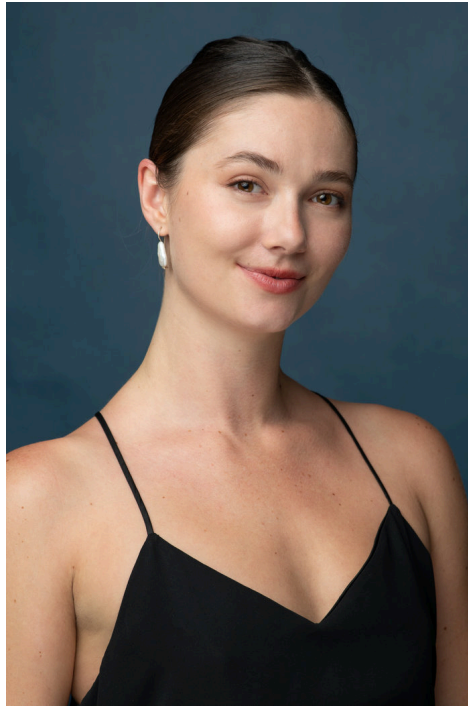
**Guest Choreographer Micah Isaiah**
